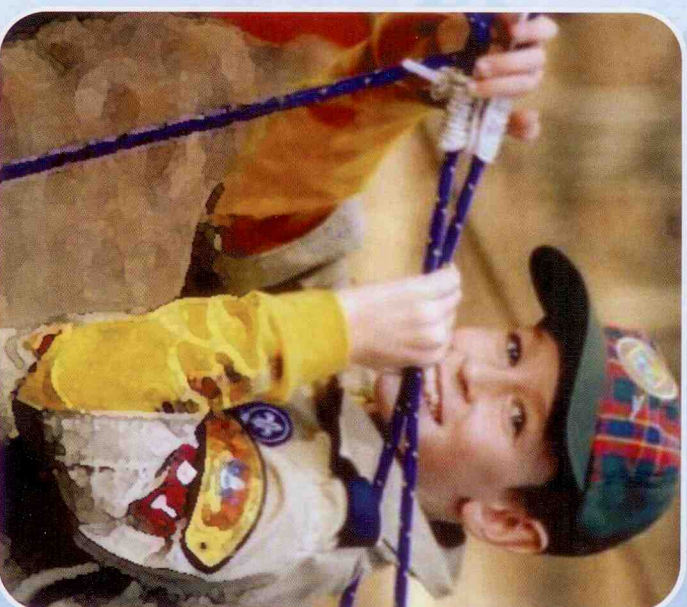

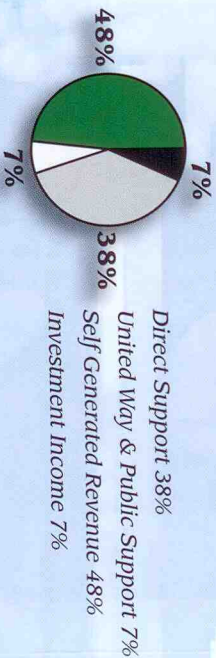

## What Is Community FOS?

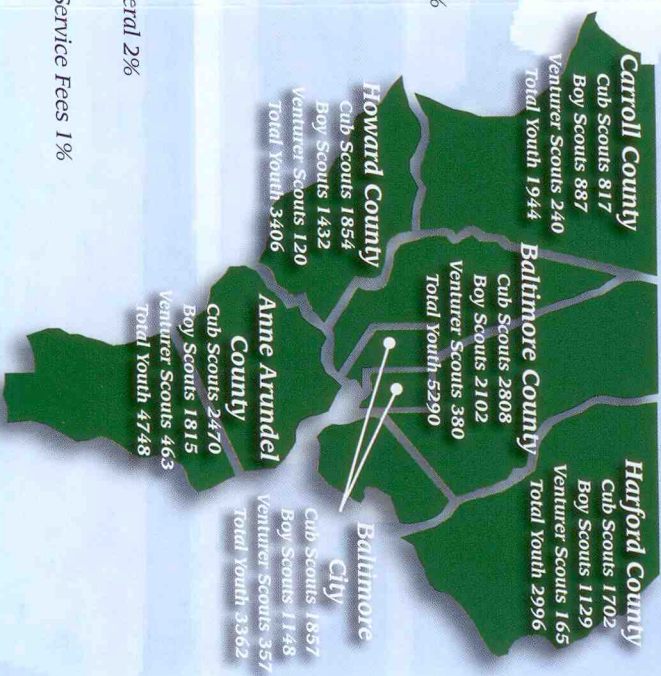
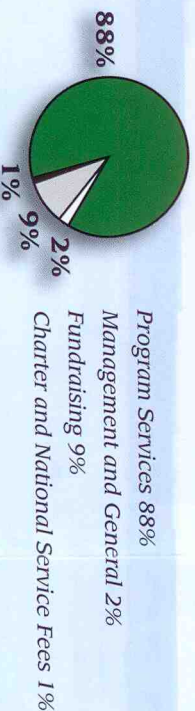
